

**LIBRARY MEDIA CENTERS**

Library/media centers will be used to support and extend the classroom program of instruction. Each center shall be provided with a collection of print and non-print materials, instructional equipment and other learning resource materials to meet the unique needs of the students. Print and nonprint materials, audio-visual equipment and supplies, and other instructional aids will be catalogued in a manner that will enable such materials, equipment, and supplies to be accessible to students and teachers throughout the school year. Library/media staff will assist students and teachers in securing materials from other sources.

The superintendent shall establish procedures for the selection of materials. Citizens who wish to express a concern about specific material included in the collection may do so according to the procedures outlined in 2020P, Selection and Adoption of Instructional Materials.
