

STUDENT HEALTH

The superintendent shall arrange for health services to be provided to all students. Such services shall include but not be limited to:

1. The maintenance of student health records,
2. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day,
3. The development of oral medication procedures for students requiring the use of medication during the school day and/or at school sponsored events.
4. The development of nursing care plans for each child with a potentially life-threatening health condition.
5. Consulting services of a qualified health specialist for staff, students and parents,
6. Vision and hearing screening,
7. Scoliosis screening.
8. Immunization records and screening.
9. Training and supervision of appropriate staff in care of students with special health care needs.
